Shopping List and Instructions

- Mason Jar 500 ml (wide mouth jars)
- Black Sharpie or Paint pen
- Mod Podge
- 1" wide Paint brush
- Epsom salts
- Ribbon
- Sprigs of winter foliage (Optional)
- Tea light or LED light
- Nativity printable

Step 1

Lay out all your supplies above neatly.

Step 2

Pour out the Epsom salts and put them on a cookie sheet or pie plate! (Set aside).

Step 3

Print off the Nativity scenes. Select which scene is suitable for your child, cut along the line and keep the nativity scene of your choice.

(Available at beinchrist.ca/advent).

Step 4

Cut off the extra paper from the top and roll your nativity scene and slide it into the jar.

Step 5

Once in the jar, centre it on the front of the jar (the side with NO LOGO). Fan it out a bit so that it is touching the glass as much as possible!

Step 6

Grab your black Sharpie or paint pen and begin tracing the image on the jar. Once fully traced, begin to fully colour in the image. Take your time allowing the marker to dry as you go!

Step 7

Once the image is dry, take out the paper from inside the jar.

Step 8

Grab a 1" wide craft paint brush and begin to paint the Mod Podge over the jar. Do not paint where the lid threads on to the jar. You'll need this to hold onto!

Step 9

After the jar is fully coated and still wet, roll the jar evening through the epsom salts. Sprinkle as you go too if you are finding some spots need a bit more.

Step 10

Allow the glue and Epsom salts to dry, if there are patches missing you can use your glue brush to touch up area and then sprinkle with Epsom salts again.

Step 11

At the top of the jar begin to wrap a ribbon over the threaded glass. Use a little glue along the way to hold the ribbon in place.

Step 12

Place your Tea Light in the jar and light it!
