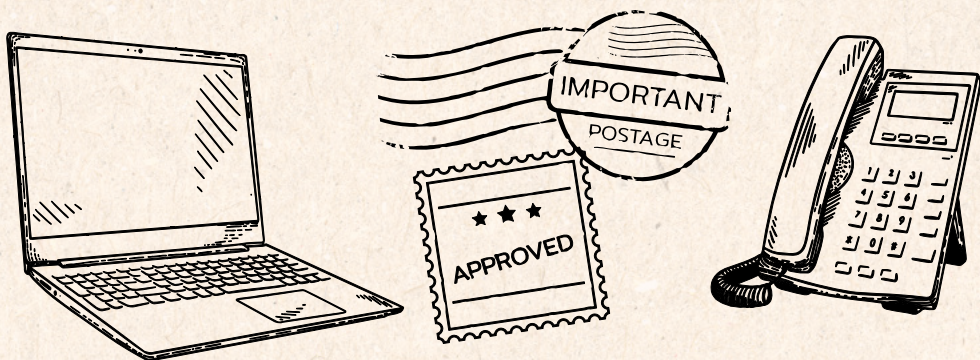

General Fund

Perhaps the least glamorous, yet most necessary, of all our funds. As a Global Team it is our desire to honour your direction when you donate funds to a specific project. Sometimes, however, we can have a surplus for one project and a pressing need elsewhere with no balance.

By directing your funds to the General Fund, you expand the possibilities for ministry. We would be grateful if you considered this fund.



Church Planters [Nepal]

We have committed to funding the salary of five church planters who work in various areas of Nepal. Due to the remote locations of many people in Nepal, these church planters travel significant distances to introduce people to Jesus and to disciple them.

FYI: \$170 pays a church planter's salary for one month. \$2040 pays a salary for the entire year.



Electric Motorcycles [Cuba]

Transportation is a huge barrier in Cuba with exorbitant costs for cars (\$100,000 or more for a 10-year-old used car) and gas costs are about \$1.30 a litre which is similar to Canada; however very expensive when we remember the average Cuban earns less than \$1.00 a day.



Here in Canada, we buy motorcycles for fun. In Cuba, it is the wisest, most cost effective mode of transportation.



FYI: \$3000 buys an electric motorcycle.

Global Relief Fund

(Formerly known as World Hunger Fund)

This fund acts as our "Emergency Fund" and allows us to respond quickly to immediate needs such as COVID relief, humanitarian aid and natural disaster response. Your generous donations to this fund ensure we maintain a healthy balance so we are poised to respond quickly when needed.



Ministry Support [Haiti]

In the past few years we have been forging a new relationship with the country of Haiti and partnering in support of Haitian pastors. The earthquake in 2021 further complicated ministry.

Your support of this project will help pastors and churches carry out ministry.



Macha Mission Hospital [Zambia]

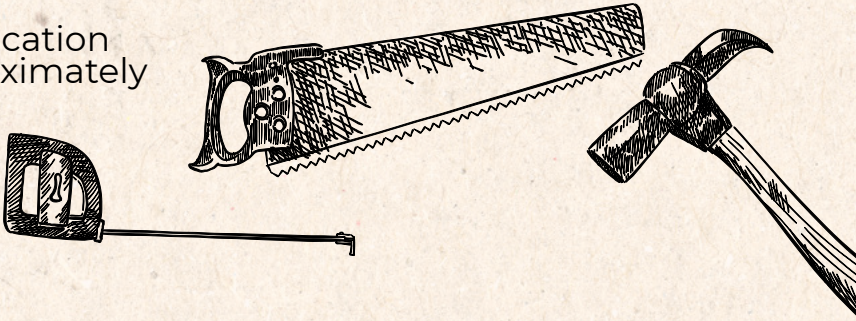
Funds given to this project help to fill in the gaps where there is insufficient and intermittent government support. The hospital uses these funds towards expenses such as electricity bills, essential medications and improvements to infrastructure.



Home Repair for Pastors [Nicaragua]

Many of the homes of pastoral families in Nicaragua are not fit to live in. This project is addressing this most basic need for a sturdy structure, a safe roof overhead and a toilet.

FYI: Each location costs approximately \$1500.



Cafeteria/Kitchen [Nicaragua]

The construction of a cafeteria and kitchen is the next stage of development at the BIC National Centre. This will enhance the food services for groups using the BIC National Centre.

This addition will increase the rental potential and provide income.



Retirement Project [Nicaragua]

Retired Pastors of BIC Nicaragua do not benefit from a government pension once they are no longer able to work. The church purchases calves to raise and sell.

The income from the sales is used to replenish the herd and each year they provide a \$1300 benefit to three pastors.

FYI: One calf costs approximately \$400.

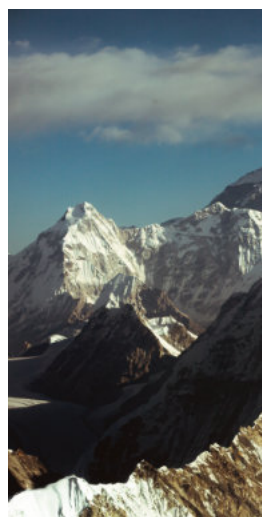


Nepal PEACE Project

PEACE stands for Providing Essential Assistance for Children's Education. Each student is given an opportunity to attend a public school and be part of a program that provides tutoring, basic food and healthcare as well as spiritual formation activities.

This after-school program operates in the local church and reaches beyond the student to the entire family.

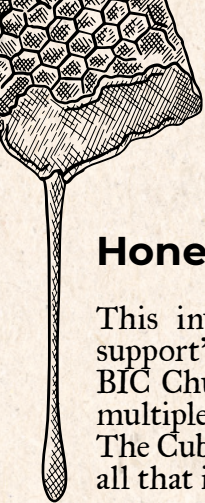

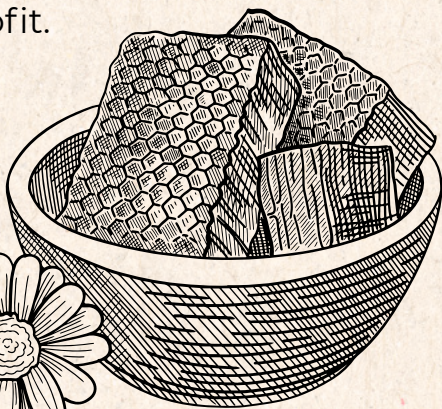

Honey Bees [*Cuba*]

This investment provides the start-up costs for a project of “self-support” which will provide ongoing income for the extension of the BIC Church in Cuba. This honey-bee project will fund the start-up of multiple hives along with the equipment needed to manage them well. The Cuban government is encouraging the production of honey and buys all that is produced, taking responsibility to pick it up and pay for it.

FYI: A \$4300 investment will produce \$4500 per year in profit.



Humanitarian Aid [*Venezuela*]

Daily life in Venezuela has been harder than usual for a few years now. We send regular support in an effort to ease those daily struggles and remind them they are seen and heard. Partner with us to be the hands and feet of Jesus.



Core Support [*Cuba*]

We send support quarterly to BIC Cuba. Political unrest, COVID 19, and economic hardships have created difficult living conditions. Church leadership is a high calling & also a difficult one so we walk alongside our brothers & sisters during these days.

Furniture Replacement [Zambia]

Through your generosity over this past year, we have been able to send funds and piece by piece, this furniture is being replaced.

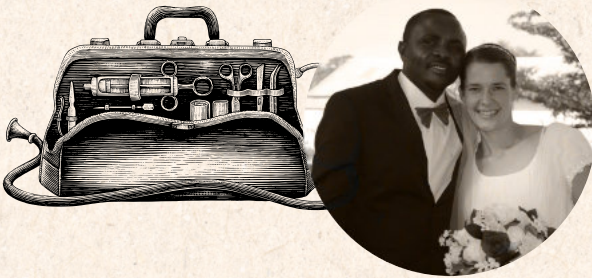
The need still exists and students still need tables, desks and chairs!
